Jerry started Trap shooting in 1958 with his father Orville Born and he shot in North Central Kansas Trap League during high school. He graduated from the University of Kansas and then attended graduate school at the University of Iowa where he was awarded a PHD in 1970. While at Iowa he shot on the Iowa Trap and Skeet team, which won the first collegiate championship in 1969. Jerry was introduced to trap shooting in New Mexico by William Garver III (Bill) at the Albuquerque Trap Club and he started shooting ATA in 1992. He has won a number of events including the 1994 T or C Handicap, the 1998 NM Handicap, the 1999 NM AA Singles, 1998 NM Class A doubles, 2004 NM Double Runner-Up, 2019 Sr. Veteran handicap, Sr. Veteran Doubles 2014, the 2014 Sr. Veteran singles, 2014 HOA Sr. Veteran as well as various other events. He has shot 100 straights at 7 NM trap clubs. His fondest memories are shooting with friends and family especially Parker and Jared Cannon his grandsons.
