GENERAL INFORMATION

This is an invitational tournament and the management of the San Juan Wildlife Federation Trap Club has used reasonable care in preparing this program. Management reserves the right to change, modify, or alter this program at their discretion. Management reserves the authority to reject, refund, or disqualify any contestant who, in its judgment, interferes with the safe conduct or sportsmanship of the tournament. Harassment, abuse of trap help or shoot personnel will result in disqualification. Orange Dome targets will be used and traps will be set at the beginning of each event and will be adjusted only by club or shoot officials.

Autoloaders must have either a shell deflector or shell catcher in place so as to not interfere with other shooters.

The club will open at 8:00AM for practice.

This certifies that the San Juan Wildlife Federation has been authorized to hold a Registered Trap Shoot at Farmington, NM on September 16th and 17th, 2023. The ATA rules will govern the shoot and the scores will be included in the official record.

Ties in Event 2 will carry-over to Event 5 except when yardage is gained and ties in Event 3 will carry over to Event 4.

Championship Singles will include Events 1A and 1B for the total 200 targets. Options will be paid on the separate 100 target events. Trophies will be awarded on the 200 target total.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Classification will be based on official averages and known ability. Shooters with no established average will be placed in not less than Class B in Singles and Doubles, and not less than the 20 yard line in Handicap. Ladies and Juniors with no established average will be placed in not less than Class C and not less than the 19 yard line in Handicap.
