



GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Ladies and Sub-Juniors with no established average will be placed in not less than Class C in singles and doubles and not less than the 19 yard line in handicap. Male shooters upon becoming 15 years old will be assigned a handicap of not less than 20 yards.
