ENTRANCE.

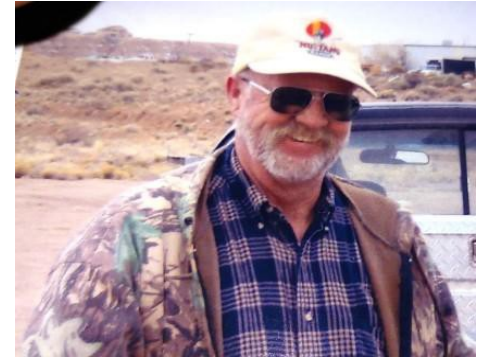

CLASSIFICATION WILL BE BASED ON OFFICIAL ATA AVERAGES & KNOWN ABILITY. SHOOTERS WITH NO ESTABLISHED AVERAGE WILL BE PLACED IN NOT LESS THAN CLASS B AND NOT LESS THAN THE 20 YARD LINE IN HANDICAP.

LADIES AND JUNIORS WITH NO ESTABLISHED AVERAGE WILL BE PLACED IN NOT LESS THAN CLASS C AND NOT LESS THAN THE 19 YARD LINE. KNOWN ABILITY CAN TAKE PRACTICE SCORES INTO CONSIDERATION.
